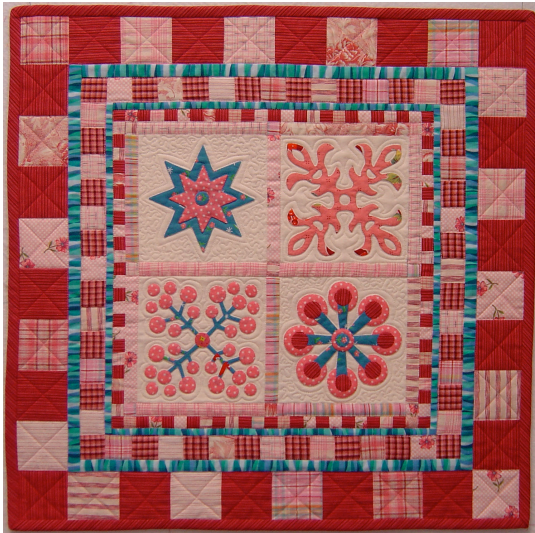

Little Bitty Eensy Teensy

Intermediate to advanced skill level only.

Little bitty appliqué isn't scary once you know the secrets!

This class can be taught as a
*1-day class on hand appliqué techniques, or
*2-day class *combining* appliqué techniques and color.

I will provide a pattern for this quilt. Although this quilt is not shown in it, the 5" x 5" blocks are from our book, *Appliqué Delights*.

Supply List

Books:

I recommend these books but they are not required for class.

- The New Appliqué Sampler by Piece O' Cake Designs
- The blocks in this little quilt are taken from the book, Appliqué Delights, by Piece O' Cake Designs. You do not need the book to make this quilt.

Fabric for a 1-Day Appliqué Techniques Class:

Pre-wash all fabric before class. It appliques better!

We will stitch on the 2 blocks on the left side of the quilt in class.

Background Fabric:

- Cut 2 squares 7" x 7"

Appliqué Fabric:

- Bring a few scraps of fabric approximately 6" x 6" in the colors you want to use.

Fabric for a 2-Day Combination Class:

Pre-wash all fabric before class. It appliques better!

Background Fabric:

- Cut 4 squares 7" x 7"

Appliqué Fabric:

- Bring a variety of small scraps of fabric in the colors you want to use. The more fabric you have, the happier you may be.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Small, sharp, paper scissors
- Small, sharp, fabric scissors
- An ultra fine point Sharpie marker
- Two (*four for the 2-day class*) 5" x 5" squares of clear upholstery vinyl in a medium weight. Keep the tissue paper that comes with the vinyl.
- One (*two for the 2-day class*) sheets of clear, heavy weight, self-adhesive laminate – available at most office supply stores or on our website (pieceocake.com). Get the single-sided sheets, not the 2-sided pouches. Avoid repositionable laminate.
- I will supply you with 2 needles and some 1/2" sequin pins. You will need additional pins. I prefer 1/2" sequin pins for pinning appliqué.
- I will have some Superior Masterpiece 100% cotton thread for you to sew with in class. If you would like to bring thread from home to use in class, I recommend these 100% cotton threads: Superior Masterpiece, Aurifil 50 weight, Mettler 60 wt., DMC 50 wt machine embroidery thread, or YLI Soft Touch cotton.
- White Chalk Pencil (I like the General's **charcoal** pencil in white)
- A General's Sketch & Wash pencil *OR* a Quilter's Ultimate Mechanical Pencil
- A sandpaper board or bring a sheet of fine grain sandpaper if you don't have a board.
- Baggies for your templates
- For a 2-day class, bring a flannel or other **design wall** that is at least 36" x 36" and tape or pins to hang it.
- For a 2-day class, bring additional pins to pin pieces to your design wall.
- **Optional** - A light and an extension cord in case the room is dark. I have no control over whether outlets will be available in the classroom - but we can hope that there will be!
- **Optional** - Many people find that applique is easier if they have a pillow in their lap to rest their forearms on. It's a good idea to bring a pillow to class for this purpose.
