**Supply List**

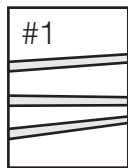
- This class is taught as a 1-day class on hand appliqué techniques
- I will provide a pattern for each student.

**Book:** *Recommended, but not required.*

- The New Applique Sampler by Piece O' Cake Designs

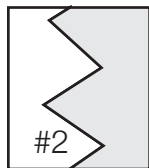
**This is the fabric that you will use in class:**

*Pre-wash all fabric before class. It appliques better!*



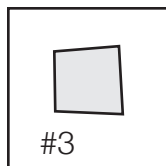
**For Block 1, the "sticks" block:**

- Cut 1 rectangle 8" x 10" in your foreground color
- Cut 1 rectangle 8" x 8" for the "sticks"



**For the Block 2, the "pointy" block:**

- Cut 1 rectangle 9" x 10"
- Cut 1 rectangle 9" x 10"



**For the Block 3, the "window" block:**

- Cut 1 square 10" x 10" in your foreground color
- Cut 1 square 6" x 6" for the "window" opening
- Cut 1 square 3" x 3" for a circle

## **Fabric needed for the entire quilt:**

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*This is a scrappy quilt. You will need small amounts of a variety of fabrics for the blocks. Use the following yardage amounts as a guide.*

Light Fabrics: 2 yards

Darker Fabrics: 1 3/4 yards

Backing and sleeve: 1 3/4 yard

Binding: 7/8 yard

Batting: 40" x 52"

## **Basic Sewing Supplies:**

- Small, sharp, paper scissors
  - Small, sharp, fabric scissors
  - An ultra fine point Sharpie marker
  - One 7" x 8" rectangle of clear upholstery vinyl in a medium weight. Keep the tissue paper that comes with the vinyl.
  - Two sheets of clear, heavy weight, self-adhesive laminate – available at most office supply stores or on our website (pieceocake.com). Get the single-sided sheets, not the 2-sided pouches. Avoid repositionable laminate.
  - I will supply you with 2 needles and some 1/2" sequin pins. You will need additional pins. I prefer 1/2" sequin pins for pinning appliqué.
  - I will have some Superior Masterpiece 100% cotton thread for you to sew with in class. If you would like to bring thread from home to use in class, I recommend these 100% cotton threads: Superior Masterpiece, Aurifil 50 weight, Mettler 60 wt., DMC 50 wt machine embroidery thread, or YLI Soft Touch cotton. All are fine, strong, 2-ply threads.
  - White Chalk Pencil (I like the General's **charcoal** pencil in white)
  - A General's Sketch & Wash pencil *OR* a Quilter's Ultimate Mechanical Pencil
  - A sandpaper board or a sheet of fine grain sandpaper if you don't have a board.
  - Baggies for your templates
  - **Optional** - A light and an extension cord in case the room is dark. I have no control over whether outlets will be available in the classroom - but we can hope that there will be!
  - **Optional** - Many people find that applique is easier if they have a pillow in their lap to rest their forearms on. It's a good idea to bring a pillow to class for this purpose.
